Pursuant to New Jersey code (N.J.S.A. 18A:7C-6.6) school districts are required to provide parents and guardians information on any state assessment or district assessments that will be administered during the school year by October 1st.

Some assessments are required by the State and Federal government, and others are administered by the Ocean Academy Charter School District to inform instruction to meet the varied and individual needs of our students.

District benchmark assessments include LinkIt, iReady, DIBELS 8th Edition, running records as well as both teacher and school developed assessments. These assessments are administered throughout the school year to determine student growth and progress. The following are the tests that students in our school district will participate in for the 2025-2026 school year. Most of the tests are computer-based. Ocean Academy Charter School provides accommodations and modifications for students who may need more assistance as per their IEP or 504 plans.
